Healthcare Inspectorate Wales (HIW) checks the safety and quality of healthcare across Wales.



We have published our annual report for 2024-2025. This report shows what we did over the last year.

What we did

 We visited 163 NHS and private healthcare services.



- We listened to:
 - 3,407 people who use services, carers, and the public.
 - 1,657 health care staff members.



What we found

More people are speaking up



- We got 743 concerns 21% more than last year.
- Whistleblowing went up by 36%.



Whistleblowing is when someone who works in a service tells someone in charge that something is going wrong. They might be worried that people are not safe or that rules are not being followed.




• These often show problems with how services are run and how staff are treated.



NHS services are under pressure

Some services are not always giving safe care.



• Sometimes things get better but then go back to how they were before.



 Sometimes there are not enough staff and some services are finding it hard to give good care.



Private healthcare is growing, but not always safely



 We had to take action more than ever before.



 Some new services might not know all the rules yet.

They may need help to learn how to keep people safe



Mental health services need to get better



 Some buildings are not safe or good places to give care.
